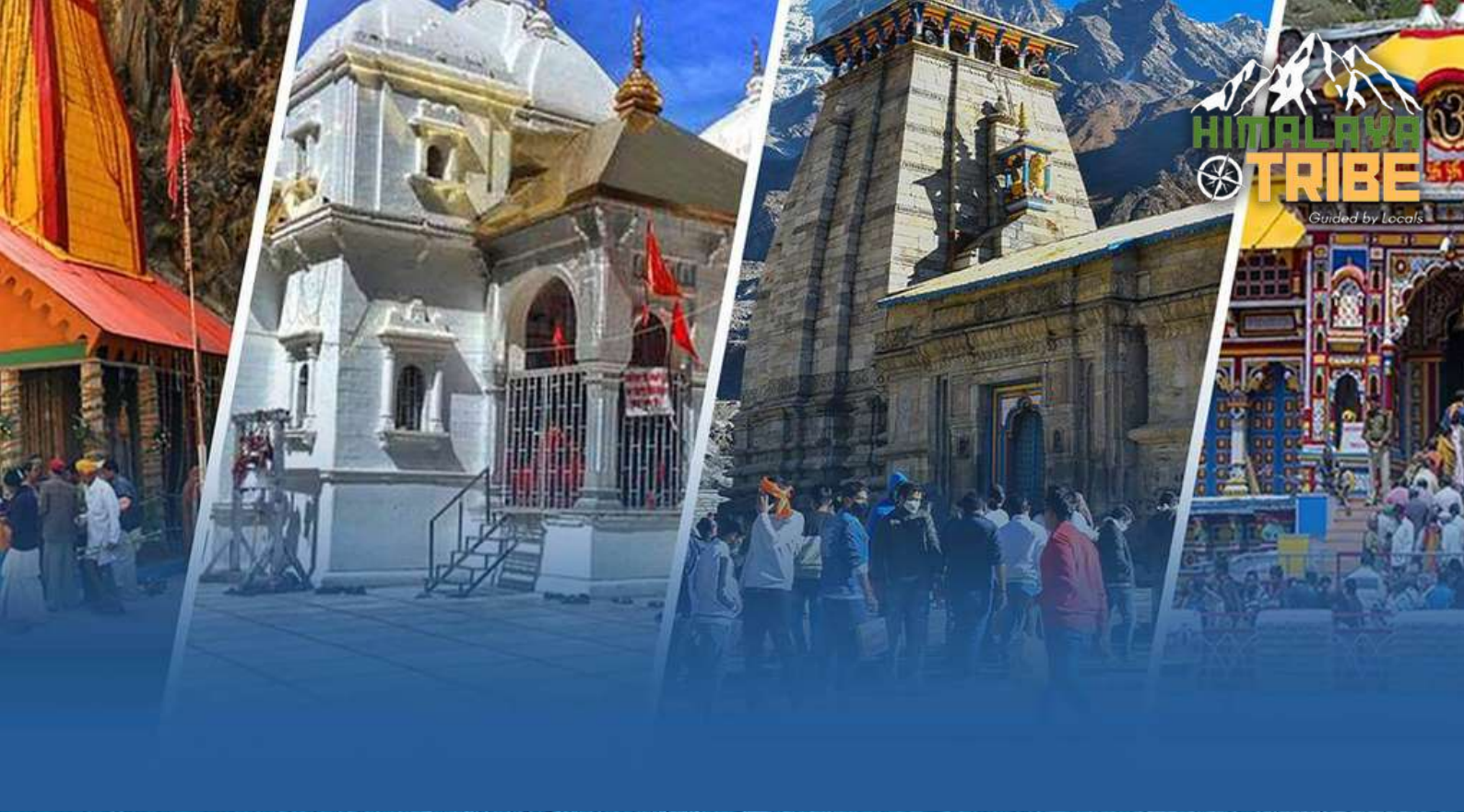

Chaar Dham Yatra

Uttarakhand is known as Dev Bhoomi (Land of Gods), as it is the land of great pilgrimages, sacred temples and places, which attracts millions of pilgrims and spiritual seekers to get enlightenment. The pilgrimage of 4 Dhams located in Garhwal region are considered the most sacred places in India: Badrinath, Kedarnath, Gangotri and Yamunotri.

These four ancient temples also marks the spiritual source of four sacred rivers as well: River Yamuna (Yamunotri), River Ganga or Ganges (Gangotri), River Mandakini (Kedarnath) and River Alaknanda (Badrinath).

DAY-WISE TOUR ITINERARY



DAY 01: HARIDWAR - MUSSOORIE - BARKOT (200 KM/08 HR)

In the morning, we will depart from Haridwar and head straight to Barkot. We will pass through the picturesque valleys of Dehradun, Mussoorie, and Naugon Hill Station of Garhwal. We'll have our lunch midway. Upon arrival in the evening, we'll check-in to our hotel. You'll have the option to enjoy a nature or city walk around the hotel, or simply relax at your leisure. We'll have dinner and spend the night at Barkot.



DAY 02: BARKOT - YAMUNOTRI - BARKOT (45 KM/03 HR + 6 KM/SIDE TREK)

The day starts early with a refreshing cup of tea or coffee before heading to Janki Chatti, the starting point for a 6 km trek to the Yamunotri Dham. The trek takes the entire day, with meals self-provided. The highlight is visiting the Yamunotri temple in the majestic Himalayas to seek blessings from the idol of Goddess Yamuna. After the temple visit, the return trek to Janki Chatti leads to a ride to Barkot for the night. The evening is free for leisure activities before dinner and an overnight stay in Barkot.

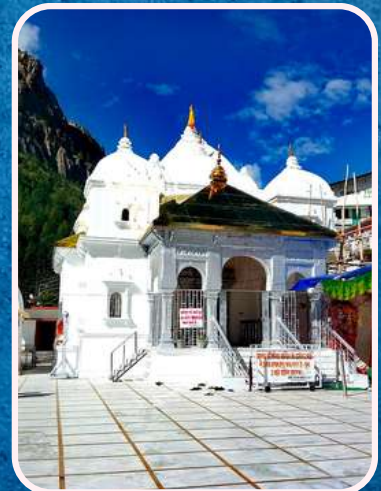
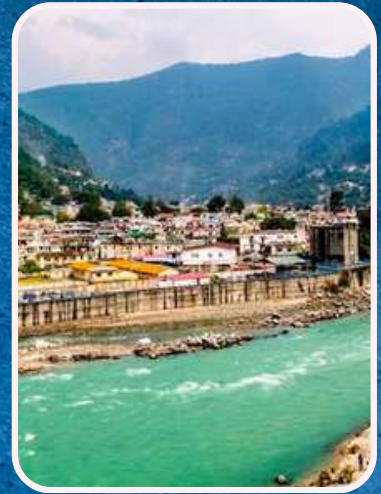


DAY-WISE TOUR ITINERARY



DAY 03: BARKOT - UTTARKASHI (85 KM/04 HR)

Cosy morning, get relaxed well. Get refreshed and have your hot breakfast at the hotel. Post breakfast checks out from the hotel and proceeds to Uttarkashi. En-route explores the famous Vishwanath Temple. Lunch midway. The evening arrives, get check-in to the hotel, and free for your leisure. Having dinner and overnight stay at Uttarkashi.



DAY 04: UTTARKASHI - GANGOTRI - UTTARKASHI (100 KM/04 HR/SIDE)

Wake up early, get refreshed, and have your hot breakfast at the hotel. Post breakfast, board the vehicle and proceed to explore Gangotri Dham. En-route enjoys picturesque Harsil Valley, Bhagirathi River, and the most magnificent views of the snow-clad Himalayas. After Gangotri Darshan, returns back to Uttarkashi. Lunch midway. The evening returns back to the hotel at Uttarkashi. Having dinner and overnight stay at Uttarkashi.

DAY 05: UTTARKASHI - GUPTKASHI (220 KM/10 HR)

Wake up, get refreshed and have your hot breakfast at the hotel. Post breakfast check out and proceed to Guptkashi. En route enjoy the beautiful valleys of Chamiyala, Ghansali, and Agastmuni. Lunch midway. The evening arrives, get check-in to the hotel. Evening free for your leisure. Having dinner and overnight stay at Guptkashi.



DAY 06: GUPTKASHI - GAURIKUND - KEDARNATH JI

There are two ways to reach the Kedarnath temple: by road and by air.

By Road - A cab will take them to Sonprayag, with a caution about potential traffic in the high season. From Sonprayag, local transport is available to reach Gaurikund, the base camp for the Kedarnath trek. The trek is 16 km long and takes approximately 5 hours, with alternatives like using a Dolly/Pony available.

By Air - Helicopter services provide a time-saving and scenic route to the temple. The journey involves taking a cab to the helipad, completing formalities, and then flying to Kedarnath. Upon arrival, visitors can check into a hotel, rest, and explore the surroundings, concluding with dinner and an overnight stay at Kedarnath.



DAY-WISE TOUR ITINERARY



DAY 07: KEDARNATH-SONPRAYAG (14 KM/01 HR)

Wake up early, do necessary shopping for the temple puja, and can also book a special pooja on additional charges. After darshan and pooja ceremony, visitors return to the hotel, pack, and check out. Breakfast is had in Kedarnath, followed by a trek or flight down to Sonprayag/Guptkashi, enjoy bonfires with light music, and conclude the day with dinner and an overnight stay at Sonprayag.



DAY 08: SONPRAYAG-BADRINATH (224KM/07 HR)

The morning investigates the stunning sunrise at Sonprayag. Post breakfast checks out and proceeds to Badrinath. En-route explores Gopinath Temple at Gopeshwar, and Narsingh Temple at Joshimath, and Govindghat. Lunch midway. The evening arrives, get check-in into the hotel. You can explore the surroundings and Badrinath temple in the evening. Back to the hotel, having dinner and overnight stay at Badrinath.

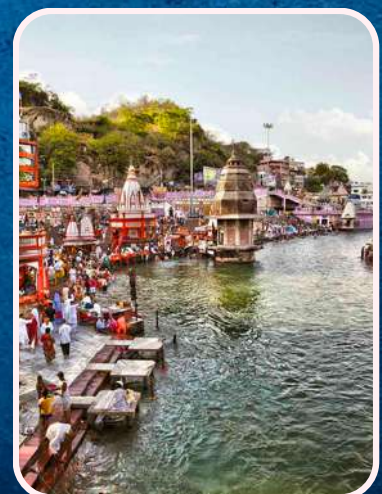
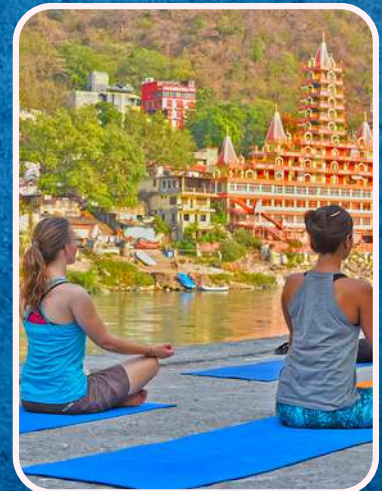
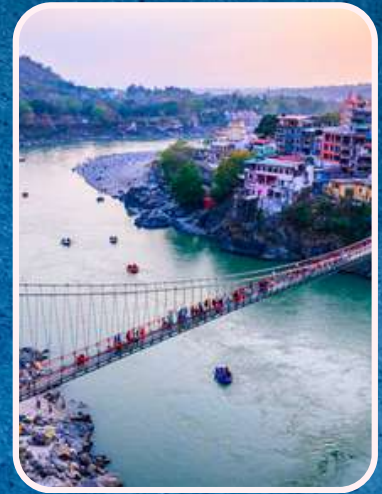


DAY-WISE TOUR ITINERARY



DAY 09: BADRINATH JI - HARIDWAR (305 KM/08 HR)

Wake up early, get refreshed, and do the necessary shopping for the pooja at Shri Badrinath Ji. Take a hot bath in a natural spring hot pond at Badrinath Ji, which is also known as Tapt Kund. After having the bath you can choose to stay in line or you can skip the line by applying for a special pooja. After having the darshan and pooja ceremony back to the hotel. Have your hot breakfast at the hotel and check out. Post check out proceeds straight to Haridwar.

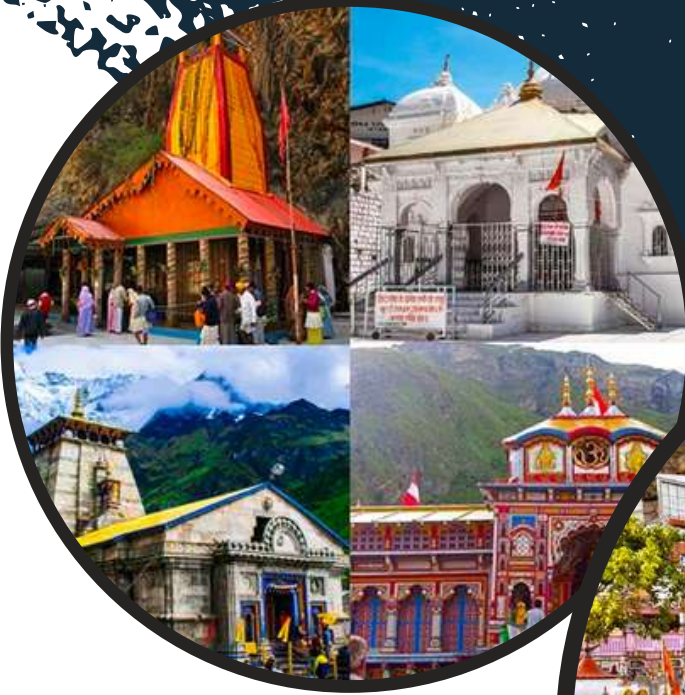


CANCELLATION POLICY


1. Cancelling before 30 days before the yatra date, 10% will be charged for each individual.
2. Cancelling before 20 days before the yatra date, 25% of visit cost would be charged as maintenance.
3. Cancelling before 15 days before the yatra date, half of the visit cost would be charged as maintenance.
4. Cancelling before 07 days before the yatra date, the whole visit cost will be charged as maintenance and no refund will be provided.

POINTS TO BE CONSIDER

- 1) Please carry a photo Id and proof of the address along with you and If Possible can carry BSNL and Airtel SIMs.
- 2) Do carry woolens from Oct to February.
- 3) Carry a good Doctor Consulted First Aid Box.
- 4) Carry good walking shoes: - canvas or sport shoes
- 5) If you wish you can carry dry eatables with you like biscuits, snacks, and chocolates, etc.
- 6) Move slowly and steadily and give the driver enough time to rest.
- 7) Carry sufficient money to pay for your personal expenses.
- 8) Avoid carrying heavy jewelry during the journey.
- 9) Don't throw wrappers/poly bags on the road or in the forest during the journey.
- 10) Don't carry poly bags as it is banned in Uttarakhand.



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
